



Halfway there: Lord Mayor Councillor Leon Unczur is pictured with pupils and staff at Farborough School Technology College's new £17 million building, which has reached mid-point in its construction. The new school is being constructed in controlled conditions off site, to improve the quality of the finished product and reduce build time by six months. After staff and pupils have moved into the new building in September, most of the existing school buildings will be demolished to make way for mini-pitches and a flood-lit artificial pitch which will benefit the Clifton community. The renewal of the school is being financed by a Private Finance Initiative through the former Government's Building Schools for the Future programme. It was the last school in Nottingham to be funded this way.
