Meet the buyer in Nottingham

Local businesses invited to work on construction projects in Nottingham.

On 21 June, Nottingham's Local Education Partnership (LEP) is hosting a breakfast meeting at Notts County Football Club, to enable local companies to meet Carillion and its first tier sub-contractors working on many construction projects in Nottingham.

There are substantial opportunities for businesses in Nottingham to develop, to supply goods and services and to leave a legacy in the local community through a commitment to local training and employment.

Businesses will hear from Carillion and its sub-contractors about the various projects that they are currently working on and will then have an opportunity to hold 1-2-1 meetings with Carillion and its sub-contractors to discuss how their business can get involved.

This networking event will benefit local businesses that can supply any of the services listed below:

- **Construction** including brickwork, painting / decorating, carpentry and joinery, scaffolding, electrical and mechanical services, fencing, landscaping, groundworks, concreting, roofing, plastering / partitioning / dry lining and surveying.
- **Business Management** including administration, document management, time / cost / quality related skills and procurement / purchasing.
- **Facilities management** including security, waste / hygiene management, grounds maintenance, caretaking, buildings maintenance, cleaning and catering.
- **IT skills** including infrastructure cabling, hard / software and maintenance and repair.
- **Supply of materials and fittings** including everything from steelwork to stationery.

Mark Harding, General Manager of Nottingham's LEP, said, said: "We are committed to supporting local business in Nottingham, particularly in this difficult financial climate. We have set ourselves an ambitious target to ensure that 56% of our suppliers are companies with an NG (Nottingham City and Nottinghamshire) postcode and so as far as we are able, as much work as possible is given to local businesses rather than relying on bringing in expertise from other towns and cities."

To date approximately £32 million of the LEP's overall total spend has been spent with companies with an NG postcode and a further £56 million with companies within a 50 mile radius of Nottingham city.

Sub-contractors attending the event include Capita IT, Shepherd Engineering Services, PWP Building Services, Fitted Furniture Solutions, Metclad Contracts and Britspace Modular Solutions.
