

Inspiredspaces celebrates double awards success for Nottingham Schools project.

Inspiredspaces Nottingham LEP comprising support services and construction company Carillion, Nottingham City Council and BSFi is celebrating after scooping two awards at the Public Private Finance Awards for its Nottingham Building Schools for the future contract.

The project won the Best Education project category and the prestigious Projects Grand Prix award. The Grand Prix award is made to a project that has 'delivered an outstanding improvement in public services for the benefit of the community that it serves' and is selected from the winners of six other categories.

Through its joint venture partner Carillion, inspiredspaces Nottingham LEP, is delivering 32 schools and other education and leisure facilities for the Nottingham BSF programme including new build and some refurbishment and remodelling. Carillion will also provide facilities management for three of the schools over the 25-year concession period.

The annual Public Private Finance Awards are the biggest event in the public private partnerships calendar. This year's awards ceremony was held at the London Hilton on Thursday May 13.
